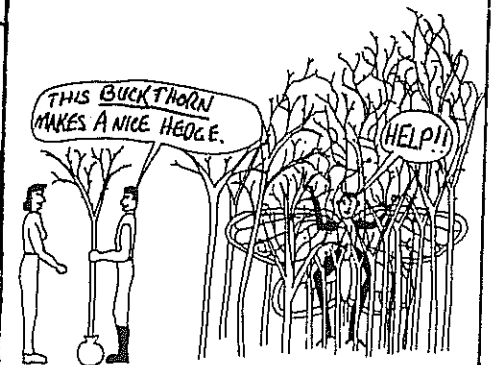
EVEN FIRE WAS A GOOD THING FOR MIKE AND HIS FRIENDS.



BUT SETTLERS MOVED IN AND DUG UP THE PRAIRIES FOR HOUSES, ROADS AND FARMS.



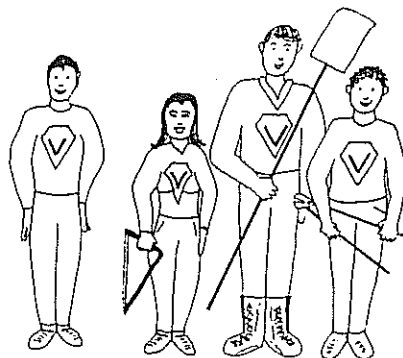
THEY BROUGHT PLANTS FROM FAR AWAY THAT CHOKED OUT THE NATIVE PLANTS.



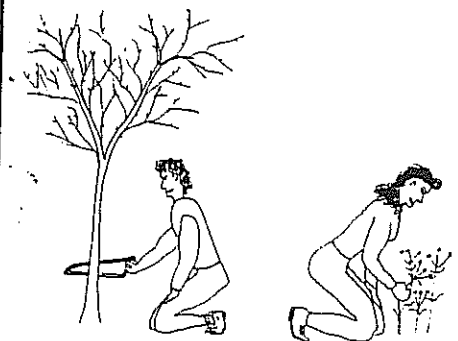

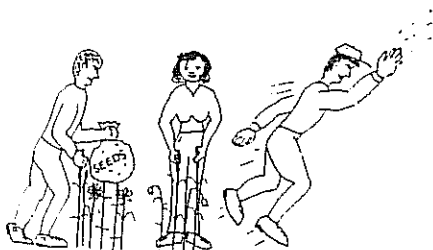


VOLUNTEERS CUT DOWN BAD SHRUBS AND PULL HARMFUL WEEDS...
