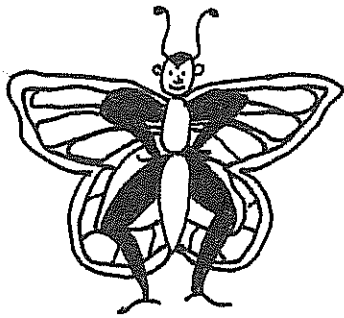
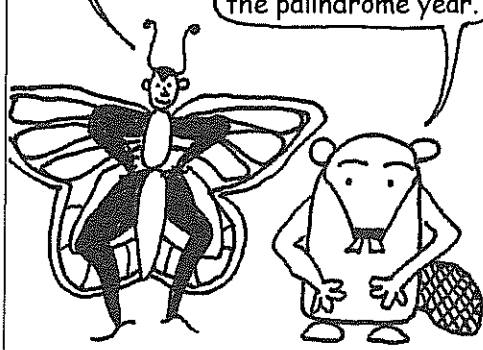

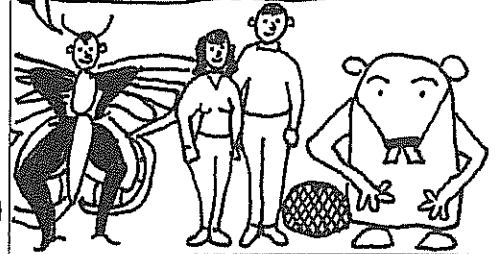


What's wrong, Bob?

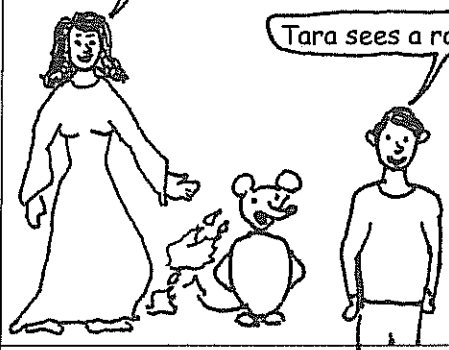
What do you say if garlic mustard is too hard to pull out of the ground?

Drat! Sumo mustard!



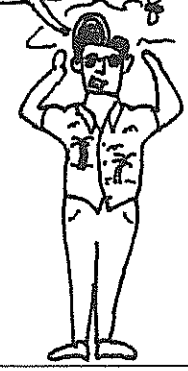
What if a rodent appears during a prescribed burn?

Too hot to hoot!



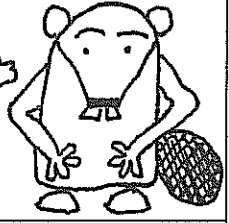
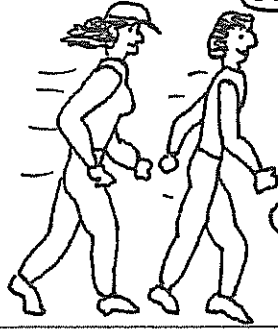
Don't wake up those water birds!

Snore, herons!



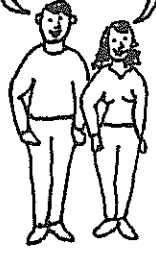
These volunteers are full of energy!
