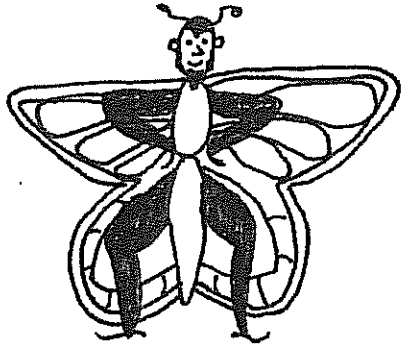

About 3-4 pounds.

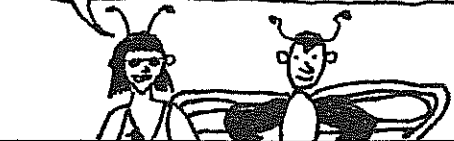


Cicero:
